## Small Door Banner

I've made several of these small door banners as gifts for friends and family, many of them by request. Make them just the right size to hang on an entry door (about 8"w x 14"h, not including tassel).

This welcome banner has been popular with my family and friends. The phrase means "a hundred thousand welcomes" in Scots Gaelic, but any phrase of welcome would do as well.

A clan badge or family crest also makes a good smallsized banner. I used an extra large size of the design (7" tall). This banner is the same length (14") as the welcome one. but a little narrower.





On each of these, the top edge is made rigid by the insertion of a flat dowel so that the corners of the banner don't droop when it hangs from the centre loop.

My friend Murphy's favourite beverage is featured on the small banner I made for his basement rec room. I made this one sans tassel.



<-----Here's another welcome banner, for a friend who's crazy about the Potter books. It's the same length as the others but hangs from a decorative rod rather than a loop.

There is actually a tassel on this Ho-Ho-Ho Santa banner, but I lopped it off to save space on the page. This vintage design is just right for a Christmas door hanging.
